## TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION

We recommend that participants book accommodation as soon as possible, as Aveiro is becoming a popular tourist destination and the conference is taking place during high season.

Accommodation should be either arranged directly with the appropriate hotels or, in the case of the student residence Complexo Residencial de Santiago, with the local organisers.

IMPORTANT WARNING! ## (1) Complexo Residencial de Santiago

Rooms at the student residence Complexo Residencial de Santiago are all single rooms without breakfast and with a shared bathroom for every two rooms. There is a limited number of such rooms and they will be allocated on a "first come, first served" basis.

price per room - 18,70 euros / night (confirmed price)

Prices do not include breakfast; however, there are several snack-bars and cafeterias spread throughout the campus where breakfast can be purchased for a few euros.

Rooms are guarantee upon confirmation of availability and a **deposit payment of 5 nights**. This payment can be made together with the registration fee and it will be returned in case of cancellation (tax fees may apply). Unfortunately, it is not possible to guarantee rooms without a deposit payment.

You should contact the organisers by e-mail to check the availability and to make your reservation. The deadline for reservation and payment for these rooms is April 30, 2019, subject to availability.

## (2) Hotels

Participants wishing to stay in a hotel are expected to book their rooms by themselves and we recommend to do this soon. There are plenty of reasonably priced hotels in walking distance of the university; the conference website has a list of suggestions with special prices available for participants. Alternatively, there also various bed & breakfast possibilities (so-called hospedarias, residenciais, and pensões), which are generally cheaper than hotels. Please keep in mind that to be eligible for the discounted fee of 140/160 euros you must complete payment by the cut-off date of April 30, 2019,

not just registration.

## **ABSTRACTS**

All Participants, who are interested in delivering a talk at the 12th International ISAAC Congress, are kindly requested to observe the following instructions for preparation of their abstracts:

- 1. Abstracts should be written in Latex, up to 300 words (about three quarters of one page in 11pt LaTeX article style). Use only standard commands provided by amsfonts and amssymb packages;
- 2. There should be **no references** and **no drawings**, **labels** or **footnotes**:
- 3. Language: English only.
- 4. Deadline for submitting abstracts is April 30, 2019.

Abstracts should be submitted via the online registration page. You can check your abstract using the **template** available at **webpage>register** and pay>abstract instruction - please do no modify or introduce commands.

Participants who wish to present a second talk should negotiate about this with the local and session organisers and, if agreed, can do so for an additional registration fee of 20 euros.
